The Nominating Committee is responsible for the initial aspects of the election process. This committee is charged with reviewing the qualifications of candidates and recommending a slate to the Board of Directors and the Association membership.

PRESIDENT'S COLUMN

MRSEA is dedicated to protecting retiree benefits and the larger our membership is, the better we can protect those benefits. For this reason, we will be having our second newsletter membership drive. I hope you will aid us in our effort to increase our membership. Please read the membership drive article in this newsletter and join us in our effort.

Minnesota public pension plans still face headwinds such as anti-public pension sentiment and the pressure to lower the assumed rate of return which would negatively impact pension funding. In addition, there is always the possibility of longer life expectancy or market downturns that can affect pension funding.

Do you know a retired State employee who hasn't joined MRSEA? Do you know a former member of MRSEA who let his/her membership lapse? Are you in a bridge club or on a bowling team with some retired state employees? Please ask them to join MRSEA.

The reason we need retired state employees to join MRSEA is to influence the legislature and to block anti-public employee groups working to change public pension plans.

We need to influence the legislature because they control pensions and can change public pensions in the next legislative session. Our new ability to communicate with our members through email means we can notify our membership of any threats to public pensions and how MRSEA plans to respond.

There are groups seeking to undo defined benefit pension plans such as ours. These groups would prefer the State change to less certain and potentially lower paying defined contribution plans. We must counter misleading information these groups propagate with accurate information about the advantages of defined benefit pension plans.

Please encourage other retired state employees to join MRSEA so they will be well informed about public pension issues and will aid us in protecting our earned benefits.

If you are interested in serving on the Board of Directors, please submit a letter of interest to the Nominating Committee.

This letter should include:

- a short statement of 100 words or less regarding your work history;
- skills you would bring to the position;
- what you would like to accomplish; and,
- your name, street address, email and telephone number for future contacts with you.

The deadline for submission is MARCH 6, 2020.

The Nominating Committee will review the letters of interest and the names of other potential candidates. The committee will consider candidate expertise, geographic representation and other qualities when recommending the slate of Board endorsed candidates. The committee will notify all candidates of the Board's endorsement decisions. Candidates not endorsed will be given the opportunity to have their name placed on the annual voting ballot.
